Uniformity vs. Conformity

Today's non-uniform day got me thinking about uniform...polished shoes, pressed blazers, pretty pinafores, hats, and of course, freshly cut hair. When picturing pupils in their uniform, I began to see the individual twists with which some pupils wear their uniform. I was minded to consider; is the purpose of a school dress code to produce uniformity? Or to promote conformity?

MAGIC? OR JUST MATHS?

THE SCIENCE OF CARD TRICKS AND OTHER ALGORITHMS



Within my Headmaster's lesson this week I have tried to bring the magic...

I'll begin with a confession; I am by no means magic. I can, however, accurately follow processes.

Many magic tricks, particularly the one I tried with the children this week are *algorithms*. A set, repeatable process, which if completed accurately, has one possible outcome.

Before seeing each class I set up my *trick*, placing one card in a particular position of the pack and hiding another in an envelope.

With a little misdirection and showmanship I then dealt out the cards, resulting in the magic card remaining. Upon opening the envelope, the pupils revealed the same magic card.

The trick is based upon a binary search algorithm which can be visually demonstrated with some punch cards. Through this method, it is simple to show that regardless of the order of the punch cards, the search always results in the same card. Watch the video to see which one...
